### Why start a Composting Program in Beyarmudu?

The Beyarmudu Home Composting Pilot Program is being launched to demonstrate a productive and environmentally friendly way to convert your organic household waste into rich organic compost and reduce the amount of waste dumped into the local dump site at the same time. The Beyarmudu Home Composting Pilot Program will help turn your trash into treasure.

### Who Should Volunteer?

Any household in Beyarmudu interested in making a difference for their garden, reducing the amount of waste they dump into the dump site by turning their trash into a valuable organic compost and protecting the environment.

### What is Composting?

Composting is an inexpensive, natural process that transforms your kitchen and garden waste into a dark rich substance called compost or humus which is a valuable food for your garden.

### Why Should You Compost?

Home composting can



- ✓ turn your trash into treasure - valuable organic compost
- ✓ cut smelly household waste by over a third
- ✓ save money by providing a free, peat-free soil conditioner
- ✓ help save water – compost helps soil retain moisture
- ✓ help your garden by improving plant health and increasing yields of fruits, vegetables, flowers & herbs
- ✓ increase the nutritional quality of home-grown foods
- ✓ provide an alternative to dumping organic waste in the local dump site

### Why Participate in the Pilot?

SAVE will provide each volunteer household with a free home composting unit and waste bin, plus hands-on training, written materials and on-going technical assistance during the 6 month pilot in exchange for your participation.
